

## **Some Types of Questions to Consider:**

### **Compare and contrast**

(e.g., “How are frogs and toads the same and how are they different?” )

### **Making connections**

(e.g., “This book says squirrels eat fruits and seeds. What did we notice squirrels eating yesterday?”)

### **Making Inferences**

(e.g., “Why do you think Fran’s flower isn’t growing?”)

### **Formulate and Express Opinions**

(e.g., “What do you think Swimmy and his fish friends should do?”)

### **Summarize**

(e.g., “What did we learn about sloths from this book?”)
